Upon consideration of various pending motions, it is for the reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, this 27 day of July, 2010

ORDERED

1. Plaintiffs' First Motion for Preliminary Injunction [Paper No. 4] is **MOOT**;
2. Plaintiffs' Renewed Motion for Preliminary Injunction [Paper No. 40] is **DENIED**;
3. Plaintiffs' Motion to Amend/Correct Amended Complaint [Paper No. 42] is **DENIED IN PART** and **DEFERRED IN PART**. The Motion is **DENIED** as to President Obama. The Motion is **DEFERRED** as to proposed additional Defendants Pelosi, Hoyer and Clyburn. Subject to reasonable extensions as may be granted by the Court, Plaintiffs are **DIRECTED** to serve these Defendants with a copy of the Second Amended Complaint and the Motion to Amend within 30 days.

Proposed Defendants Pelosi, Hoyer, and Clyburn shall have 20 days after service to file an opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion to Amend;

4. Plaintiffs' Motion to Deem Opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion to Amend Waived [Paper No. 52] is **DENIED**; and
5. Plaintiffs' Motion for Reconsideration [Paper No. 54] is **DENIED**;
