MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

Plaintiffs hereby move pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65(b) for the issuance of a preliminary directing Defendant President Barack Hussein Obama and the members of his White House staff, including all agents and employees of the President and the White House staff, from undertaking in the future to intimidate or coerce any member of the Congress to vote in favor of any health care bill, including any health care bill to be reported out of a formal House-Senate conference committee or any merged health care bill informally negotiated by representatives of the House and Senate, or to vote in favor of any measure to cut off debate on any such bill, through the use of threats to take executive action or actions that adversely affect the member's constituents. The

Court should grant the preliminary injunction for the reasons set forth in the accompanying memorandum of law.
